<p>1. What is this product about?</p>											
<p>Trade Time Loan (TTL) is an invoice financing facility which can be denominated in either foreign currency or Malaysian Ringgit to finance customer’s working capital requirements, supported by an underlying trade transaction from open account trade transactions, documentary collections or letters of credit payment terms. The Malaysian Ringgit denominated loan is known as the Trade Time Loan (TTL).</p>											
<p>2. What do I get from this product?</p>											
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum financing tenor of 5 days up to 180 days within the approved credit tenor in the Letter. • Minimum transaction amount of MYR10,000. • Unlock capital trapped in unpaid invoices thus improve working capital flow. 											
<p>3. What are my obligations?</p>											
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make full repayment no later than the maturity date of the TTL. • The documents presented to the Bank to support the financing must relate to genuine and current trade transactions. • Ensure the documents submitted for financing have not and will not be financed by any other source of financing. • Ensure sufficient funds and authorise the Bank to debit your account with the Bank for any Bank’s charges, interests, costs or expenses in respect of disbursement and repayment of the TTL upon maturity.

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<p>5. What if I fail to fulfill my obligations?</p>											
<p>Bank’s Right To Set-Off</p> <p>In the event of a default, your business/company will need to pay all additional interest, costs, charges and expenses incurred until the loan is fully repaid. The Bank may debit or set off amounts you owe to the Bank against any credit balance(s) in any of your account(s) with the Bank.</p>											

Late Payment Charges

All Trade Time Loans drawn must be paid on their respective maturity dates and if there is default in such payment, you will be charged late payment charges at the rate of 1% per annum over the Financing Rate.

Legal action

Legal proceedings may be initiated against you if you fail to fulfil your obligations under the Letter and other agreements referred to in the Letter. In addition to the amount owing to the Bank, you may be liable to pay for all losses, costs and expenses (including legal fees) incurred by the Bank to recover the sums owed by you.

Legal action against you may affect your credit rating leading to credit being more difficult or expensive to you.

6. What if I fully settle the loan before its maturity?

Early settlement of TTL is allowed but handling fees of MYR100 and break-funding cost (to be determined based on prevailing Cost of Funds at time of early settlement) will be charged.

7. Do I need any takaful/insurance coverage?

Not Applicable.

8. Do I need a guarantor or collateral?

The Bank will evaluate this requirement based on internal credit assessment including assessment based on your company/business financials.

9. What are the major risks?

- The Trade Time Loan facility is an uncommitted facility. This means:-
 - (a) the Bank has the right, at any time at its sole discretion, not to allow you to utilize the facility;
 - (b) the Bank has the right, at any time at its sole discretion, to modify, restructure, earmark, suspend or cancel the facility.
- The Bank has the right to ask for repayment of all outstanding TTLs at any time.
- There is minimum risk in terms of changes in interest rates for the duration of the loan tenor as the TTL financing rate is locked-in for the duration of the loan tenor. However, you may be exposed to foreign exchange fluctuation risk for your cross border purchases/sales as TTL financing is in Ringgit.
